## Paths and Cycle Tracks

### Description of work

Tilhill Forestry has carried out a variety of projects throughout Scotland to install paths and cycle ways for a variety of clients. Here are just a few examples.

#### WHITRIGG BING

##### Community paths

Client: West Lothian Council

Value: £48,000

- 2300m of path construction with associated drainage.
- Installation of new equestrian access, field gates, and benches.

#### EDINBURGH TECHNOPOLE

##### Business park footpaths

Client: Land Use Consultants  
Chartered Architects

Value: £91,000

- 1000m of path construction with associated drainage.
- Installation of way-marker posts.
- Reinstatement of stone steps.
- Creation of timber ramped steps.

#### BARRY BUDDON CYCLEWAY

##### North Sea cycle route

Client: Angus Council

Value: £290,000

- Construction of 4km of 3m-wide tarmac cycle track.
- Installation of approximately 6km of fencing and associated gates, signs, and bollards.
- Drainage works and culverts.

#### LUSSET GLEN

##### Community footpath

Client: West Dumbartonshire Council

Value: £18,000

- Vegetation control.
- Upgrading of footpath, handrails, and signs.
- Tree thinning.
- 80m of footpath construction (bitmac) with handrails.
- New signage/way-markers and bollards.

#### DRUMRY & BRUCEHILL FOOTPATHS

##### Community footpaths

Client: West Dumbartonshire Environmental Trust

Value: £80,000

- Footpath excavation and formation works.
- Erection of concrete steps.
- Handrail construction.
- Erection of lighting columns.
- Tarring and reinstatement works.
