## Tithebarn Green Corridor, Exeter

**Project:** Soft Landscaping works

### Introduction

Tilhill Forestry was appointed by Celtic Construction Ltd to carry out the soft landscaping works associated with the Tithebarn Green Corridor in Exeter.

The scheme was not only designed to deal with the future surface water generated from the surrounding new housing developments but also to provide an area of public open space for the new residents.

### Description of work

Works included the amelioration of all soils across the site, cultivation and seeding of wetlands areas, including aquatic planting and seeded coir rolls, areas of wild flower seeding, amenity seeding and hydro-seeding of Devon Hedge banks.

Erosion control matting was installed to steep banks. All areas were mulched with either bark mulch or decorative gravel.

We are also maintaining the site for a period of 12 months.
