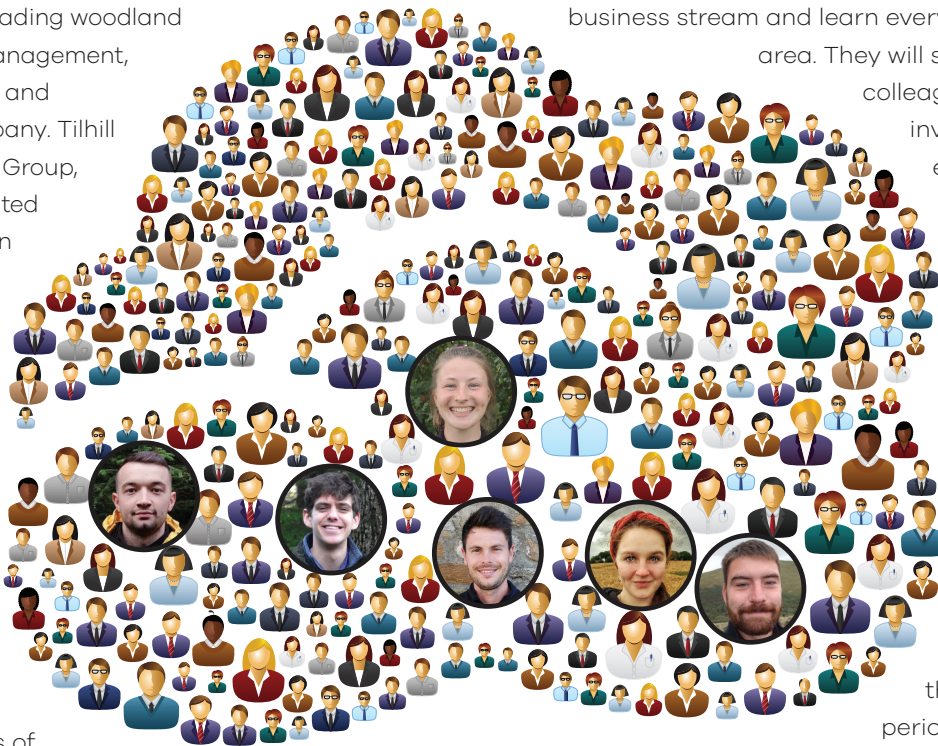
BSW Group is a rapidly developing multi-site business with a turnover in excess of £650m and operations spanning forestry, sawmilling, timber manufacturing and energy.
